Place an X through the block that talks about what you should NOT do in an earthquake.



IF INDOORS

Stand near windows, light fixtures, unstable furniture, or anything that could fall.

Run outside.

DROP to the ground; take COVER under a table or sturdy piece of furniture; and HOLD ON until the shaking stops.

Stay inside until it is safe to go outside.



IF OUTDOORS

Go to an open area.

Move away from buildings, street lights, and utility wires or anything that could fall.

Stand near a building or in an exit way.



IF IN A CAR

Stop as soon as you can, away from buildings or anything that could fall.

Stay in your car.

Drive under an overpass and get out of the car.



Always be sure to follow these steps in case of an earthquake:
